Guidelines for In-Network Benefit Eligibility

Primary Care: Applies to Care Teams AC, AM, AL, AH, FP, HE, HN, HF, HP, MH, MR, NP, NM, NS, OM, PN, SL, SV, TH, DC,

UM and all Multiple Site Community Providers. You may receive primary care services at any primary

care clinic in the Care Team or Multiple Site Community Providers you select when you enroll.

Applies to Care Teams CP, FH, FS and all Individual Site Community Providers. *Primary care services will* be provided by the clinic you select when you enroll. In order to receive primary care services at any other clinic in the Care Team or Individual Site Community Provider, you must call Customer Service to change your clinic selection. A new ID card reflecting your clinic change will be mailed to you.

Specialty Care: Applies to Care Teams AL, AH, FP, HE, HF, HN, HP, NM, NS, OM, PN, SL, SV, TH, DC, UM. You may self-

refer to any specialist associated with the Care Team you select.

Applies to Care Teams AC, AM, CP, FH, FS, MH, MR, NP and all Individual & Multiple Site Community Provider. Referrals from your primary care clinic are required for specialty care. *Your clinic will make the appropriate referral to a specialist associated with your primary care clinic.*

Guidelines for In-Network Benefit Eligibility for all Care Teams & Individual/Multiple Site Community Providers

Obstetrics & Gynecology: You may self-refer to any OB/GYN clinic in this network.

Hospital Information: Please refer to individual clinic listings for hospital information.

Urgent/Emergency Care: For urgent care needs during and after clinic hours, contact your primary care clinic or

check the Urgent Care listing in this network. For medical emergencies, call 911.

Mental Health Care: You may self-refer to any of the Mental Health providers in this network. Referrals from

your primary care clinic are not required.

Eye Exams: For ROUTINE eye exams, you may self-refer to any eye care provider in this network. For

services other than ROUTINE eye exams, you may self-refer to any specialists associated

with the Care Team you select (listed in the Specialists section).
