What is the overall deductible ?	In-network: \$1,850/\$3,700 (individual/family- \$1,850 per family member) In-network deductible is embedded. Out-of-network: \$15,000/\$25,000 (individual/family) Deductible does not apply to in-network preventive care.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care services are covered before you meet your deductible .
